Heat is the leading weather-related killer

Worsens existing health problems like asthma, kidney failure, and heart disease

Affects those working outdoors *and* indoors

Reduces sound quality of hearing aids and can even damage the aids

Heat stress killed 815 U.S. workers, seriously injured 70,000+ workers (1992-2017)

However, it is a highly underestimated hazard
